



At Sun Peaks Resort LLP, we strive to provide the finest mountain resort experience, to do so all clubs and teams will follow the Sun Peaks Resort Clubs Code of Conduct.

While enjoying your time at Sun Peaks Resort, you agree to adhere to the following Code of Conduct:

RESPECT:

- All guests, club members, staff and volunteers are to be treated in a respectful manner.
- Offensive, racist or sexist behavior, including foul language, is forbidden. Bullying, Fighting or seriously disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.

ALPINE RESPONSIBILITY CODE:

- Understand and adhere the respective Alpine Responsibility codes.

-Stay in control while skiing or boarding

-Observe and obey all posted signs, warnings, and closures

-Report all incidents or accidents to a staff member. In the case of a collision, you must stay onsite.

TRAINING:

- All training will be conducted in designated training facilities. There will be NO racing, tucking or edging skills to be conducted in the clearly marked slow, learning zone areas.

CHAIRLIFTS:

- When early morning loading is permitted all coaches, team members and volunteers will stay on designated runs.
- No swinging of or horseplay will be tolerated on chairlifts. No cell phone use will be allowed in lift lines.

EQUIPMENT & TRANSPORT:

- Only approved coaches and volunteers will be permitted to carry course equipment (fencing/bamboo etc.) on chairlifts and will ride one per chair.
- There will be no towing of Coaches, Club or Team members behind vehicles at any time

BEHAVIOR:

- Facilities will be kept in a clean and orderly manner. Ski and Snowboard racks are provided outside all facilities, all equipment will be placed on racks standing up. Theft or vandalism of Sun Peaks property or the property of others will not be tolerated.
- The use of illicit drugs on Sun Peaks Resort property is prohibited. The consumption of alcoholic beverages is restricted to those 19 and older in licensed areas. Smoking, including e-cigarettes, is not permitted in or around Sun Peaks Resort buildings, on the ski hill, in lift lines or on chairlifts.
